They drove 30,335 miles helping their community neighbors stay active & engaged.

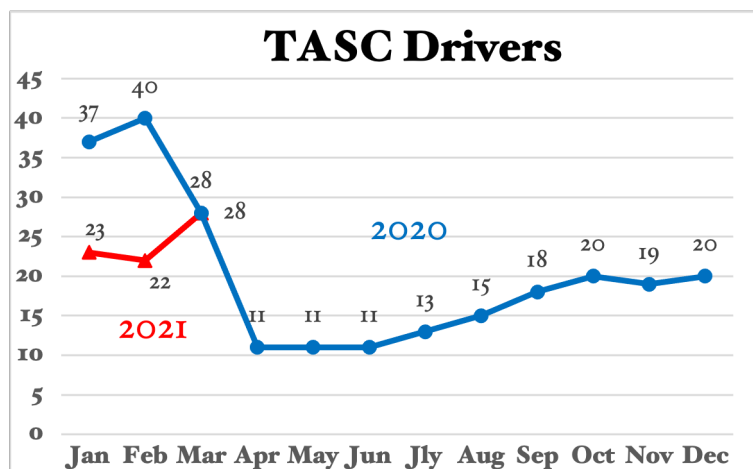
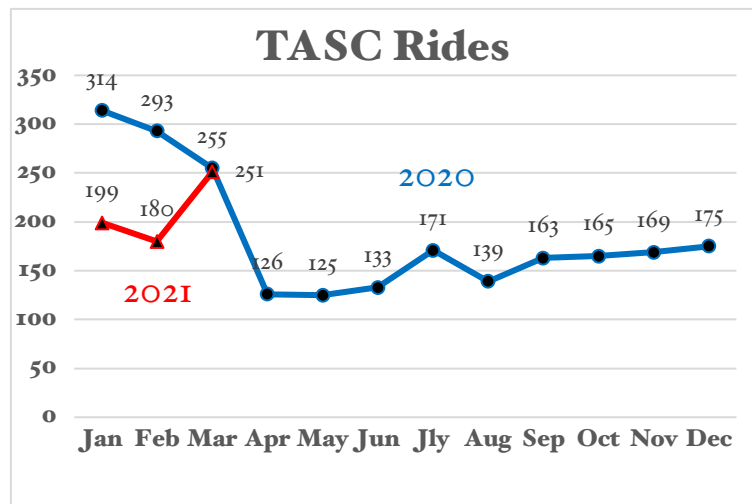
Funding
